

McKendree United Methodist Church Sanctuary

The sanctuary has four seating sections, with a large center aisle and two side aisles. There are 10 stained glass windows, each depicting a scene from the life of Christ. The sanctuary was built in 1910, and the floor slopes slightly downward, making it easier for those in the back to see. It seats between 300-350.

This photo was taken on Easter Sunday, when the children put on an Easter drama. That is why there is a small tomb and tombstone to the right of the chancel area.

The carpet is gray/tan, actually more gray than tan, even though the lighting in this picture makes it seem tan or gold color. The walls also are a gray/taupe color. The pew pads and the altar kneeling pads are green. Generally, the sanctuary is neutral in color.
